After a Sexual Assault

- ✓ Find a safe place.
- ✓ Seek medical care. Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners are on call 24/7 in every Onondaga County emergency department.
- ✓ Call Vera House for confidential advocacy and healing resources.
- Remember: it was NOT your fault.
